Instructions for running BHMT, HT and MT on OS-X or Windows platforms:

The most versatile versions of the BHMT, HT and MT programs run on a platform-independent DOS emulators. To run these programs from your Mac or Windows computer you will need to install a DOS emulator. The most popular DOS emulator for both Mac and Windows users is DOSBox.

- Download the latest version of DOSBox for your operating system at http://www.dosbox.com
 and install DOSBox on your machine
- 2. Create a "C:\dosprogs" or equivalent directory
- 3. Create a "BHT" folder inside "C:\dosprogs"
- 4. Download HT.zip, unzip and select the executable file (HT_SRC.exe) you wish to use from https://temporalpublishing.com/bht_students/
- 5. Copy the *.exe into their respective folders
- 6. Execute the "DOSBox" program
- 7. Enter the command "mount C C:\dosprogs\"
- 8. Enter the command "C:" to change the mounted drive
- 9. Enter the command "cd BHT"
- 10. Enter command "BHT SRC" to unpack programs
- 11. Repeat Steps 9 and 10 for the additional software package. Use "cd .." to move up on directory.
- 12. To execute program XX (e.g. BHMT, HT or MT), enter "cd XX" and then XX again at the DOS prompt to execute the menu program
- 13. You will need to enter the "mount C C:\dosprogs" each time you restart the "DOSBox" program.
